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Occult Dilated Cardiomyopathy Criteria in Dobermans: LVIDD >46mm if <39Kg body weight. LVIDD >49mm if >39Kg. body weight. Fractional shortening (FS) <25%. One premature ventricular beat on ECG, or more than 50 premature ventricular beats on a 24 hour Holter Monitor ECG.e longevity. This medication decreases the overall workload on the heart muscle by slowing the heart rate and reducing force of contraction with each beat.
